In Russia there is no generated psychotherapeutic tradition. The speciality "psychotherapist" has officially appeared only recently. Still for today the biological orientation is the dominating orientation in native medicine.

In the article there are briefly presented some merits and demerits of the methods of psychological support of teenagers with communicative disorders (in particular, teenagers with autistic features) which we have considered: modification of behavior, modification of the cognitive approach, training of social skills, training of parents, etc.

The results of the researches confirmed that help should have complex character (Monina G.B., Mihaylovskaya O.I., 1999; Monina G.B., 2000). As a rule the command includes a doctor-neurologist, a psychologist, a teacher. Only at the complex approach to decision of the question of education of teenagers both with the hypercommunicative and autistic characteristics it is possible to count on the decrease of its emotional pressure and fuller realization of its potential.

Features of social attitudes of teenagers-refugees.

Deformation of sense sphere centrations and regression of sense strategies' trajectories of teenagers living in the postconflict region.

During three years (2005-2008rz) this research took place in a number of areas of the Ingushetia Republic (Sungenskii, Nazranovskii) in camps for refugees and forced immigrants from the Chechen Republic.

The senior teenagers in the age of 14-17 years were the object of diagnostic research. Among the teenagers-refugees the most part was educated in forms not corresponding to their age, since during military opposition in the Chechen Republic schools did not work, and children had no opportunity to receive any education. Many teenagers have remained for repeated year of education.

For comparison of the level of sense consciousness deformation among teenagers-refugees, at the same time there have been spent the testing among the teenagers from socially safe families, pupils of the gymnasium of Nazran, and also among pupils of slavic nationalities of Rostov-on-Don, from graduates where teenagers-migrants had the same testing, as well as teenagers, the basic respondents, and have actually acted as the control group (350 teenagers).

Features of behavior in real group of minor participants of group crimes

It is shown, that among organizers of group crimes the basic tendencies of behavior in group are "independence" and a high level of "struggle acceptance", reaching expressivenesses of steady tendencies. Thus in the group "organizers – leaders" the tendency of "struggle acceptance" is more expressed and among the "organizers - not leaders" the tendency to "independence" is more expressed. In positions of leaders of criminal groups the opposite tendencies of "dependence" and "independence", and "struggle acceptance" and "struggle avoiding" are combined, that is apparently determined by the variety of functions of the leader in group. The most distinct tendency of behavior among them is a high level of "sociability".
