Victimological direction of the preventive inspection of minors' criminality

In the article the problem of victimological approach to preventive inspection of minors' criminality is raised. The actuality of the problem is explained by a number of circumstances: complexity of general victimogenic situations in Russia, steady growth of criminality caused by provocative, imprudent and risky behavior of people (potential and realized victims of crimes), weak security of victims from crimes.

The victimological approach to preventive inspection of minors' criminality is observed as one of the perspective directions which purpose is the realization of forecast of victim behavior and prevention of crimes.

It is emphasized the essential role of careless, imprudent behavior of the minor's personality, his personal victimness which are capable to facilitate a crime realized against him. It is raised the question of necessity of studying of the background of crime, personal features of victim, features of its adaptedness and protectively-coping behavior in hard situations, as unformed systems of overcoming on the one hand, becomes the factor promoting criminality, and on the other it is the factor of transformation of a minor into a victim.

"Psychotherapist-client" dyadic interaction as the subject of complex psychological research

The purpose of the article consists in statement of a problem of complex studying of dyadic interactions in "psychotherapist-client" system of relations. In the first part of the article there are analyzed the conceptual models describing this interaction and developed within the frameworks of three authoritative schools of practical psychology: in hypnotherapy, in psychoanalysis of Z. Freud and in client focused therapy of K. Rodgers. In the second part it is undertaken an attempt to develop the model of therapeutic relations on the basis of native humanitarian traditions with attraction of ideas of M.M. Bakhtin and cultural-historical concept of L.S. Vigotsky. In the light of the cultural-historical approach the interiorization mechanism of the effective sign means of self-control as the basic condition of efficiency of psychotherapy is discussed. In the third part four groups of socio-psychological factors of dialogical interaction of the client with the psychotherapist, not considered in the above examined concepts are observed.
