The author analyzes the ways of presentation of the psychoanalytic doctrine which created different “images” of psychoanalysis for soviet readers in 60th, 70th and later, traces historically as the relation to psychoanalysis gradually changed, plans prospects of further historical researches in this field. Variants of presentation of psychoanalysis were as follows: 1) extremely negative critical presentation and attitude to psychoanalysis as useless, harmful and false theory (in that case any detailed information and references often were absent); 2) negative critical presentation that in the same time contained details of Freud findings and the history and sources of his ideas (sometimes it gave readers useful information for their own considerations); 3) detailed critical revues which were available thanks to the translation of the books of the foreign psychologists who were Marxists; 4) presentation that reflected the gradual changing of the relation to psychoanalysis (in that case were not only critical remarks but also acknowledgment of some important problems put forward by psychoanalysis was presented; 5) presentation of the period of ‘confession’ and ‘turn to psychoanalysis’; 6) very positive presentation, apologetic attitude to psychoanalysis without any critical remarks
