

РЕЗЮМЕ ВЫПУСКА НА АНГЛИЙСКОМ ЯЗЫКЕ

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The functional organization of brain cortex in professional and amateur musicians during musical improvisation

The role of music for the development of personality's creative potential is shown in the article. The necessity of studying of functional organization of brain cortex in musicians during the improvisation as a creative activity is substantiated.

The technique and procedure of empirical research conducting are described. 47 musicians aged 18 to 39 years – professionals (22 pers.) and amateurs (25 pers.) participated in the study. They were asked to listen to musical harmony, mentally reproduce each of them, and then create an improvisation based on them. EEG method was used to study the strength and nature of coherent cortical connections during the musical activity in participants.

As a result of the made comparative analysis the peculiarities of brain cortex's functional organization for different frequency bands in musicians with different levels of professionalism during improvisation are revealed. It is concluded about strong interaction of the brain's parts during musical improvisation process of in professionals and about brain's parts interaction in right hemisphere mostly in amateurs.
